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Important Pre-Injection Procedure Checklist

• You must arrange for a driver to take you home from the procedure center if you have sedation or certain types of procedures/injectates.

• No food or drink for 8 hours before your procedure, when receiving sedation; 4 hours if no sedation. You should take any regular medication, such as blood pressure medications, with only a sip of water.

• If you receive **IV sedation**, an adult must be with you for 12 hours after the procedure and **you cannot drive a vehicle for 24 hours. You may not travel by plane for 24-48 hours after your procedure, with or without sedation.**

• If you are **diabetic**, you must **plan** for the pre-injection fasting and the possible post-injection, steroid induced, increase in blood sugar. Please be sure to discuss this **with your primary care physician prior to the procedure**, so that you have a plan established for managing these.

• <u>Please notify our office if you are taking blood thinners of any kind, aspirin, or anti-inflammatory</u> <u>medications.</u> The decision of whether to stop taking the blood thinner before a procedure is complex. The factors to be considered include the risk of the procedure being performed vs. the risk of coming off the medication. It is sometimes riskier to hold the anticoagulants than to do the procedure while taking them.1, 2 <u>PATIENTS SHOULD NOT TAKE THEMSELVES OFF ANTICOAGULANT MEDICATION</u> <u>WITHOUT DIRECTION FROM THEIR PRESCRIBING DOCTOR/PRACTITIONER.</u>

• Notify your Injectionist, if you have a fever or have an infection of any kind.

• Notify your Injectionist, if you have an iodine, IV contrast, latex, or other pertinent allergies.

• Do not have any dental work done 14 days prior to your injection.

• Bring any related radiology imaging (disc/USB) including (X-rays, CT scans, and especially MRIs) to your procedure for review. Exceptions are recent imaging at Health Images, Touchstone, or Invision.

• Please note that there will be multiple charges related the injection procedure. These charges are for the physician, facility, and the anesthesiologist/nurse anesthetist.
